# Where your daughter's early learning journey begins

Learning in our purpose-built early years facility, The Coach House, is hands-on and purposeful. We create a stimulating, challenging curriculum that reflects the needs and interests of our pupils, making learning relevant and engaging.

We offer flexible options tailored to your schedule. Girls aged 3+ can attend for a minimum of two full days or four half days, with the ability to add more as needed.

Our bespoke curriculum combines STEM and creative opportunities, offering an individualised academic and pastoral experience. Your daughter will be known, understood, and her unique learning style embraced to help her reach her full potential.

We focus on seven key areas of learning to ensure a well-rounded education:

**Prime areas:** Communication and language, physical development, personal, social, and emotional development.

**Specific areas:** Literacy, mathematics, understanding the world, expressive arts, and design.

In our Junior School, your daughter will benefit from a small class size of around 20 pupils, ensuring she receives the individual attention she deserves. As an all-girls' school, we excel at providing the right mix of support, inspiration, and challenge, tailored to each girl's needs.

Our innovative and broad curriculum is delivered in specialist learning spaces, helping pupils discover their preferred learning styles and prepare effectively for Senior School. Through our academic enrichment programme, your daughter will deepen her knowledge and develop essential skills like resilience,

leadership, and teamwork. Our integrated curriculum connects core subjects, offering a broader understanding of how and why learning is relevant.

To ensure your daughter's needs are met, we regularly assess progress using a variety of methods, including informal questioning, self-evaluation, peer feedback, and teacher reviews. This comprehensive approach goes beyond the SATs system, focusing on how each child learns best and whether learning objectives are achieved.

This tailored approach ensures a seamless

transition from Preprep to Junior School and prepares her for her transition into Senior School, continuing your daughter's journey of growth and discovery.

As well as being academically focused, we believe in supporting your child's educational journey by also helping them to discover what truly inspires and motivates them. By focusing on intrinsic motivation, independence, and self-awareness, we guide them in

understanding where they are now and where they are headed next.

Our approach leads to consistently strong results, whether in STEM subjects, the creative and performing arts, languages, or humanities. These achievements. including impressive Value-Added scores, are due to our commitment to each child's individual growth and development.



# Your daughter's enriched learning adventure

Our holistic curriculum blends traditional learning with creativity, challenge, independence, and discovery. By integrating subjects like Science, Art, Geography, and Music under one unifying topic, we help your daughter see the relevance of each discipline in context.

For example, exploring a topic like The Titanic allows pupils to reflect on the lives of people at the time (History and English), design and build boats (Engineering), and investigate concepts of floating and sinking (Science).

#### **Enrich and extend**

 We have a comprehensive PAT Policy (Potential, Able, and Talented) designed to both support and challenge our most capable girls, ensuring they reach their full academic and personal potential. This policy provides tailored opportunities that foster their unique talents and encourage them to excel in all areas of school life.

 Workshops, and talks: From illustrators and authors to medics and scientists, our pupils engage with professionals who are leaders in their fields We also host 'Raising Girls' talks featuring both internal and external experts. offering valuable insights for parents, our students, and the wider community to support the development of young women.

Being in Cambridge, we take full advantage of the city's incredible museums, exhibitions, and resources.
Whether it's robotics at the Cambridge Science Centre or conservation at the Museum of Zoology, all of Cambridge becomes our classroom.

Reflecting our values as a Mary Ward School, our Development Education programme introduces important global issues like poverty, hunger, inequality, and environmental challenges. As your daughter grows she will learn how to incorporate the five Mary Ward values - freedom, joy, justice, truth, love - into her daily life.















### How our girls learn

As the Cambridge school for girls, we know that an all-girls learning environment offers your daughter the freedom to explore her strengths and passions without the limitations of gender stereotypes. Here, she'll be encouraged to build confidence, resilience, and independence in an environment designed specifically to help girls thrive. With personalised support and a focus on collaboration, she'll develop the skills and self-assurance she needs to excel academically and grow into a strong, capable young woman ready to take on the world.

#### **STEM**

We inspire a love for STEM from age 3 through specialist teaching, exciting talks, and our dynamic award-winning Yingting Qian STEM Lab, where pupils can experiment and innovate. Our girls have achieved impressive results in national STEM competitions, such as achieving scores in the top 10% in the national Bebras Computational Thinking Challenge, and achieving Distinction Awards in the Oxford University Computing Challenge placing then in the top 1.5% of all entrants.

#### Arts

Creative arts are integral, with workshops, drama lessons (including LAMDA exams), and music sessions, helping girls build confidence and express themselves. Our vibrant music programme includes opportunities for

singing in choirs and performing in events and concerts both within the school and at prestigious venues such as Our Lady and the English Martyrs (OLEM) and The Grand Arcade. These performances allow our pupils to showcase their talents and develop a lifelong love for the arts...

#### Languages

Pupils study
French while also
experiencing a range
of other languages,
including German,
Spanish, and Latin,
as part of our

commitment to broadening horizons and providing our girls with diverse learning opportunities. This exposure not only fosters a love for languages but also opens doors to a world of cultural understanding and academic growth.

#### **Outdoor learning**

We believe the outdoors offers incredible opportunities for growth, well-being, and the development of essential life skills. We are very fortunate to have such a beautiful outdoor space on our school grounds, along with easy access to both urban and rural environments just beyond our doorstep.

We want to make the most of these spaces and ensure that learning outdoors is a regular part of our girls' experience, not limited to specific times. Whether it's enhancing their understanding of the world, encouraging teamwork, or simply allowing them to explore in a handson way, we're

committed to offering this opportunity throughout their day and week.

Outdoor learning isn't just about being outside - it's about challenge, adventure, and developing the whole person. It also allows our girls to see their teachers and peers in a new light, fostering positive relationships and greater selfawareness With our dedicated Head of Outdoor Learning guiding both the Junior and Senior School

we are confident that spending more time outdoors will encourage collaboration, creativity, and a deeper sense of enjoyment in learning.

We look forward to seeing how this approach enriches their school experience.

### **Sport facilities**

Developed in partnership with Homerton College, part of the University of Cambridge, to deliver our ambitious vision for sporting education, our sports ground on Long Road includes:

- Athletics facilities for track and field
- AstroTurf pitches for hockey, rugby, and football
- Cricket nets
- Netball and tennis courts
- Floodlighting
- Pavilion with kitchen and changing rooms

In addition to these excellent facilities, we offer a wide range of enrichment opportunities in sports such as quidditch, fencing, judo, and swimming, providing our girls with diverse and exciting ways to stay active, develop skills, and challenge themselves.

### Flexible boarding options to suit your family life

From Year 5 upwards, we offer a range of flexible boarding options to suit your family's needs:

- Full-time boarding: Your daughter lives at school throughout the term, returning home for half terms and holidays.
- Weekly boarding:
   She can enjoy school during the week,

- returning home on weekends and rejoining on Sunday evening or Monday morning.
- Flexi-boarding: Whether it's an occasional night, a regular evening each week, or several weeks at a time, this option offers flexibility for busy schedules.

Alongside their academic growth, boarders take part in a variety of enriching activities across Cambridge – punting on the River Cam, attending Evensong at King's College, enjoying cream teas, and exploring the city's historic and cultural sites
