Winter uniform

- School blazer (1)
- School jumper (1)
- School blouse (short or long sleeved) (1) OR Navy School polo shirt (1)
- School skirt (the skirt must be to the top of the knee or longer) (1) OR School trousers (Navy only) (1)
- Tights (black or navy) (2) OR socks (navy/white, kneelength) (2)
- Hairbands (black or navy, plain) to tie hair up during practical lessons and physical activities (3)
- School storm coat/thermal sports coat (optional) (1)

Summer uniform

All of the above, except tights should be skin coloured and socks white/navy ankle length.

Shoes (2)

School shoes or boots should be black or navy, of a plain style and with a low heel. Sandals, slippers and trainers are not permitted. Please see attached image for examples of footwear which will help in your decision.

Outdoor wear

A smart, warm and waterproof overcoat should be worn to and from school. Girls must also wear their school blazers to and from school each day. Whilst in the interest of safety we do not insist that the coat is navy or black, the coat should be smart and, therefore, hoodies, denim jackets, leather jackets and non-school jumpers/hoodies are not permitted. Colourful/patterned scarves and gloves may be worn.

We do not have a regulation school bag but girls should ensure their bag is big enough to carry their IT equipment, files and books safely and comfortably.

Cycling

Students cycling to school must ensure they have a lock sufficiently robust to be used at all times on school premises. Parental permission will be required for a boarder to purchase a bicycle and to use it. We support safer cycling and recommend that girls wear a cycle helmet and fluorescent belts or vests when cycling to and from school.

Jewellery

Girls can wear one pair of small, plain, stud gold or silver earrings. They must however be removed for PE/Games sessions or covered with micro-pore tape (provided by parents).

Girls can wear plain, discrete styled watches. Only single necklaces with discrete, religious symbols can be worn and these will need to be removed for swimming/PE/Games sessions. Ankle and wrist bracelets must not be worn.
